

John Paul II declared in *Evangelium Vitae*:

“When a parliamentary or social majority decrees that it is legal, at

least under certain conditions, to kill unborn human life, is it not really making a ‘tyrannical’ decision with regard to the weakest and most defenseless of human beings?

...In the case of an intrinsically unjust law, such as a law permitting abortion or euthanasia, it is therefore never licit to obey it, or to take part in a propaganda campaign in favour of such a law, or vote for it.

...The moral gravity of procured abortion is apparent in all its truth if we recognize we are dealing with murder.”

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Cardinal Ratzinger (now Pope Benedict XVI) wrote to American bishops in 2004:

“Regarding

the grave sin of abortion or euthanasia, when a person's formal cooperation becomes manifest (understood, in the case of a Catholic politician, as his consistently campaigning and voting for permissive abortion and euthanasia laws), his pastor should meet with him, instructing him about the Church's teaching, informing him that he is not to present himself for Holy Communion until he brings to an end the objective situation of sin and warning him that he will otherwise be denied the Eucharist.”
